## VOTING METHOD

Voters on all motions, except election of Board officers, shall be by raised hands, not by voice vote or secret ballots. If the vote is other than unanimous, the secretary shall record, or cause to have recorded in the minutes of the meeting, the names of the Directors for and against the motion. Unanimous votes are recorded as such.

A Director should not abstain from voting except in special cases such as conflict of interest. Reasons must be provided for abstention.

All motions shall be carried by majority except as otherwise required by law.

No motions may be made or voted in executive session.
